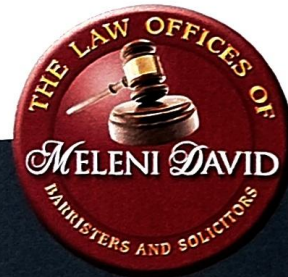

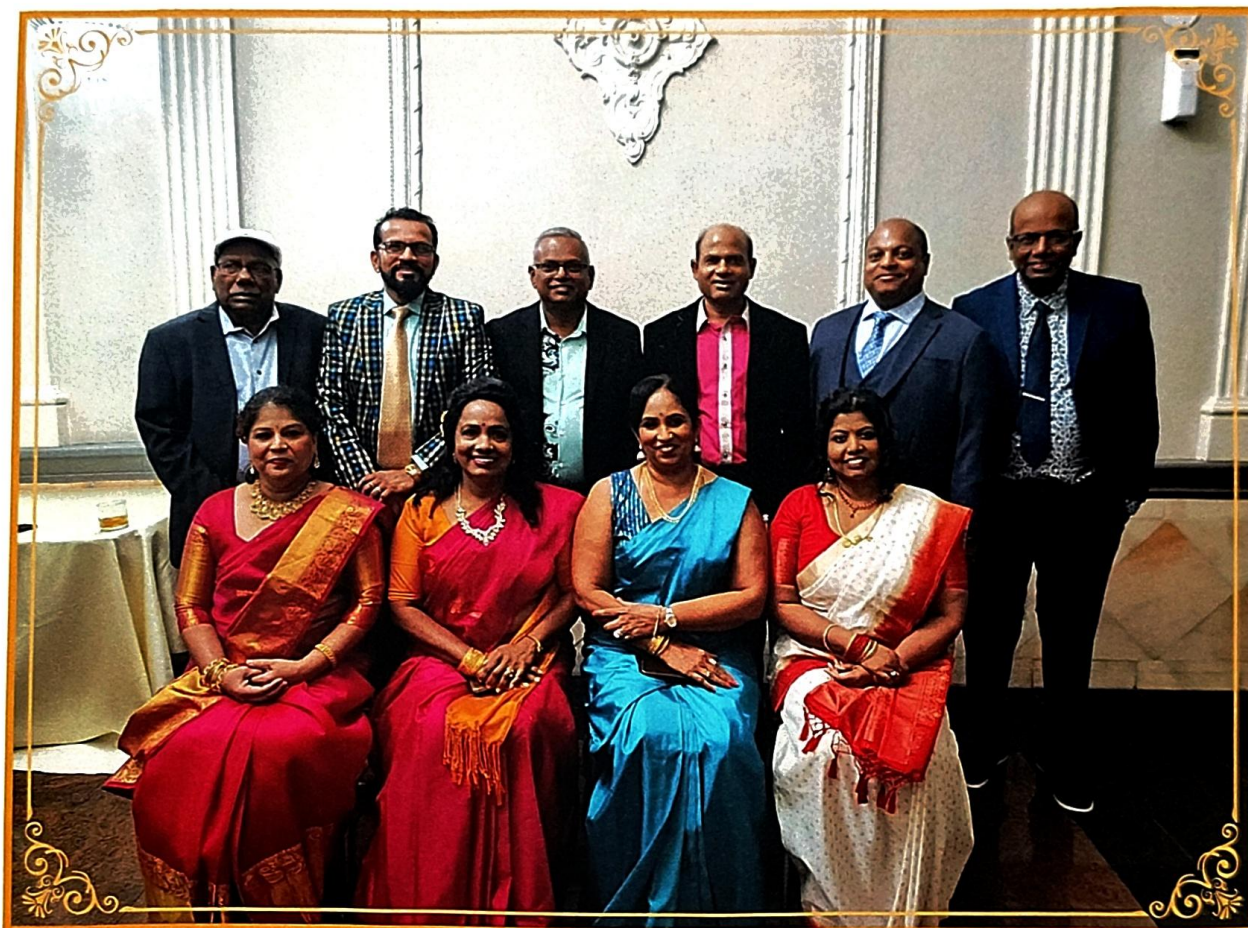

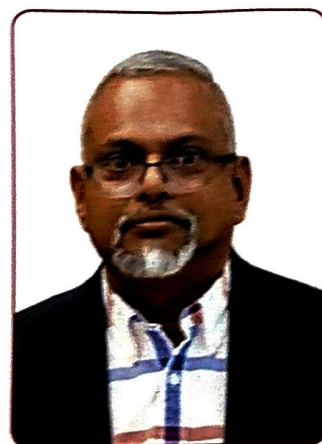

Mannar Basin: Sri Lanka's New Frontier for Energy Exploration

Promise, Potential, and Responsibility Beneath the Waves

Sri Lanka is preparing to open international tenders for oil and natural gas exploration in the Mannar Basin, a step that could redefine the island's economic future.

The announcement, reported by the Tamil Guardian on November 4, 2025, outlines plans for granting exploration and development licenses to global energy companies.

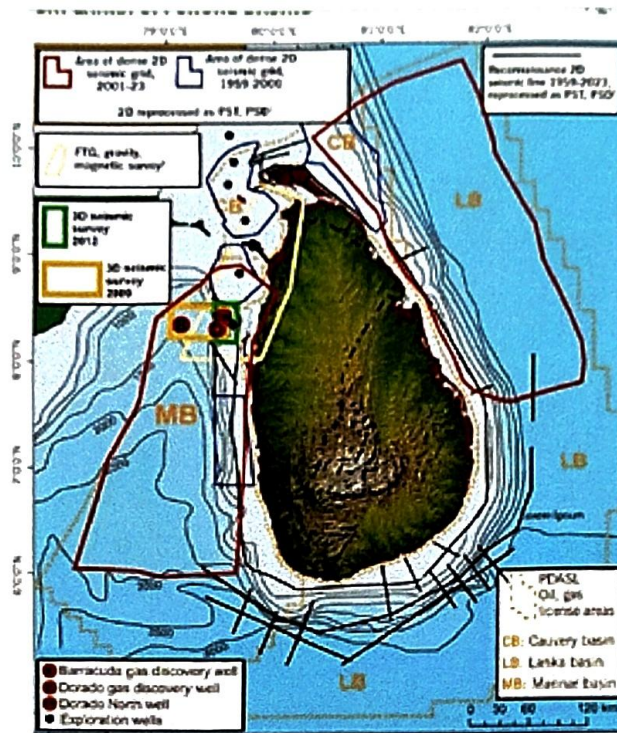
Located off Sri Lanka's north-western coast, the Mannar Basin covers a large marine region bordering Indian waters. According to the United States Geological Survey (USGS), about 66 percent of the basin lies within Sri Lanka's maritime boundary. The agency estimates that, even if only five percent of potential reserves prove recoverable, the resources could be worth approximately US \$ 6.54 billion (USGS Basin Study, 2024).

If realized responsibly, these projects could reduce the nation's dependence on imported fuel, enhance energy security, and create new employment and training opportunities for local residents — particularly for the people of Mannar District.

Yet, while the figures promise prosperity, experts and environmentalists emphasize the need for careful management and transparency. The Mannar coastline is one of Sri Lanka's most ecologically sensitive areas, home to flamingo wetlands, mangrove forests, and traditional fishing villages. Without strong environmental safeguards, exploration could threaten marine ecosystems and community livelihoods.

Local leaders and development planners are calling for a balanced approach — one that allows responsible exploration while prioritizing environmental protection and fair benefit-sharing with coastal communities.

For Mannar, long known for its history of trade, migration, and resilience, this new chapter brings both opportunity and challenge. Sustainable energy development could support education, infrastructure, and skill growth across the region — but only if guided by accountability and respect for nature.

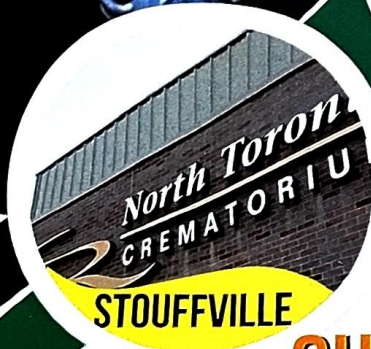
